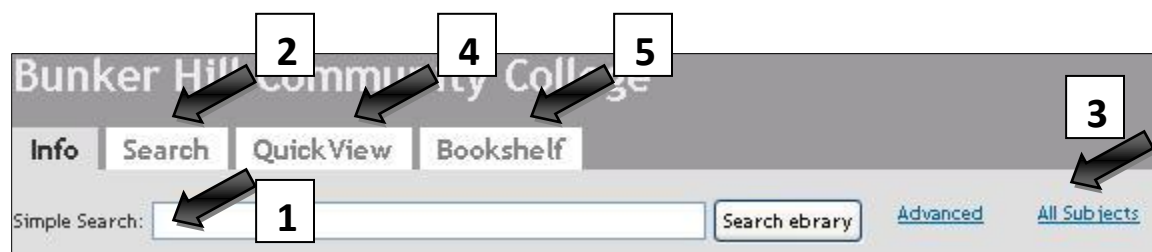
Overview

ebrary is large collection of eBooks spanning multiple subject areas. With ebrary you can search and view the full text of thousands of books through your web browser. You can also create a free ebrary account which allows you to highlight text, take notes, and create a personalized bookshelf.

Access

You can access ebrary through the library's website at:

1. The simple search box can be used for quick keyword searches.
2. Select "Search" or "Advanced" for more search options.
3. Select "All Subjects" to browse titles by subject.
4. Quickview will take you back to the last book you were viewing.
5. Bookshelf is where you can save titles for quick access the next time you use ebrary. You will need to create an account to use Bookshelf.

Creating an Account

Creating a free ebrary account allows you to access the full set of tools and features that ebrary has to offer. To create an account, click on "Sign In" and then select "Create an Account."

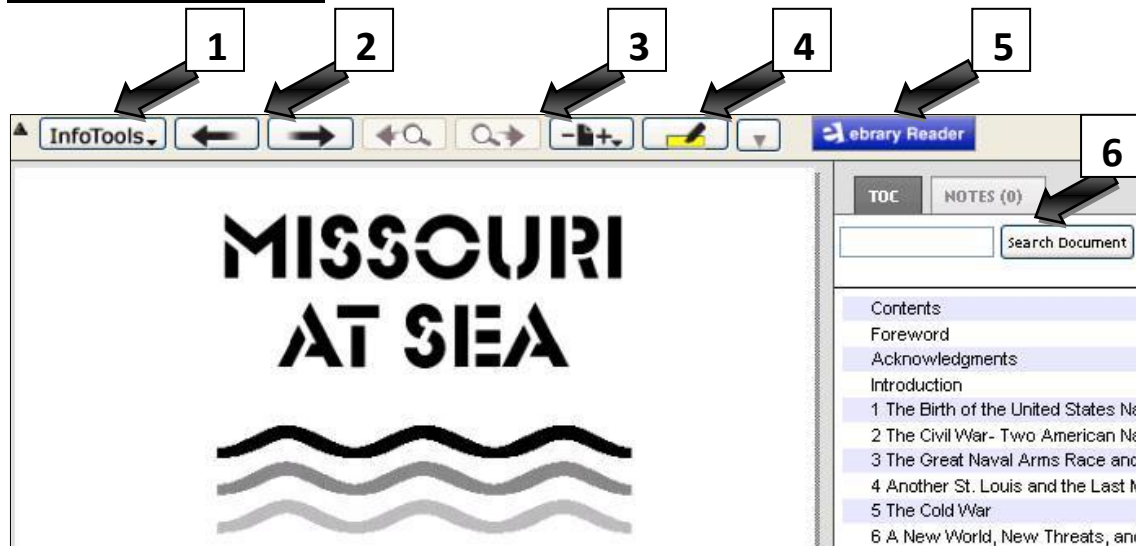

Viewing an eBook



1. The InfoTools menu allows you to copy, print, and search the web.
2. Use the arrow buttons to turn the pages.
3. Zoom adjustment and page layout
4. Highlight and take notes
5. Use the optional ebrary Reader to view the book. Note: ebrary Reader requires installation and can't be used in the library.
6. Use the table of contents to move through the book and link to chapter titles. You can also search the full text of the book using the "Search Document" field.

FAQ

1. Do I need to create an account to use ebrary?
 - a. No, but creating an account gives you access to the more advanced features of ebrary.
2. Do I need to install any software to use ebrary?
 - a. No, ebrary runs right in your web browser. You can install ebrary Reader if you want a more complete reading experience.
3. Does the library have ebrary titles in print?
 - a. The library owns some ebrary titles in print but most titles are only available online.
