Organizational History

The Peabody Historical Society and Museum was founded in 1896 by Elizabeth Cheever Osborne and is one of the oldest historical societies in Massachusetts. The Society's collections are of local and national significance. The Peabody Historical Society, at this time, owns eight historic properties scattered throughout Peabody. Among the properties is the General Gideon Foster House; the Society also manages the Elizabeth Cassidy Folk Art Museum & Peabody Art Association Gallery; Nathaniel Felton Sr. House; the Nathaniel Felton Jr. House; the Orchard House; the Apple Barn and the Peabody Engine Company No. 3. In addition the Society has a library and archive; along with a collection of furniture; dresses and costumes and the decorative arts.

Scope and Content Note

This collection documents the history of the Historical Society. Included in the collection are annual reports that list the officers of the society from 1896-1904. In latter issues the annual reports included articles by members of the society relating to Peabody's history. Also included are brochures related to the Society and the properties that it owns.

In addition, the Society also publishes the *South Danvers Wizard* newsletter. The newsletter is named after the local paper that was published in Peabody from 1859-1868. Each issue coved news and events, programs and volunteer opportunities at the Society along with recent acquisitions to the Societies collection the years covered in this collection range from 1989-2004. The collection also includes postcards that were printed by local and national companies, but several from smaller towns are photographic prints. There are also postcards that relate to George Peabody and this philanthropic work; these postcards can be found in the postcard collection.
