

Locating Materials in McQuade Library and Beyond...A Quick Guide

Books

1. Use McQuade Library Catalog to find books, videos, and more in McQuade Library.

Call Number Guide:

[ERC]: Educational Resources Collection, third floor

[Media Center]: Media Center, library basement

[REF]: Reference Room, first floor

A – H: Second floor

J – Z: Third floor

2. Also, use the catalog to search other libraries belonging to NOBLE consortium
 - You may use your PIN to request these materials directly, OR
 - You may submit an Interlibrary Loan request form to order materials, OR
 - You may go to another NOBLE member library with your Merrimack College ID to borrow materials directly.
3. If you find no suitable materials within NOBLE, search other library catalogs or OCLC WorldCat to borrow materials via Interlibrary Loan. Ask a librarian for help!
Start your research early! Interlibrary Loan can take at least a week, and sometimes more!

Articles

1. Start with an online subscription database (see McQuade Library web site or your Course Research Guide for suggestions) or a print index to locate article citations and text.

Four Ways to Locate Articles:

- Full-text online in the database you are searching
- Full-text online in another subscription database (see “Print and Electronic Periodicals List” -- <http://www.noblenet.org/merrimack/serials/jnlsIndex.html>)
- McQuade Library subscribes to the print journal (see “Print and Electronic Periodicals List” -- <http://www.noblenet.org/merrimack/serials/jnlsIndex.html>). Print journals, magazines, and newspapers are located in the Periodicals Room on the second floor of the library.
- Submit an Interlibrary Loan form to request the article from another library.
Again, start your research early – Interlibrary Loan takes a while!
