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On a comparison of the present list with that of last year, it will be seen that there is an increase of twenty-nine vessels—twenty-one schooners, one sloop, and seven boats—with an aggregate increase of 1483.85 tons. This increase is mostly in Gloucester Harbor, although there is an increase in all of the other sections of the District excepting Essex. Gloucester has added seventeen schooners and three boats to her list, and increased the tonnage 1214.90 tons—the average tonnage of the schooners has also been slightly increased.
