The foregoing List of Vessels enrolled in the District of Gloucester, which is made up to August, 1874, comprises the names of four hundred and ninety-seven vessels, the aggregate tonnage of which is 29,019.84 tons. This is a decrease of sixteen in the number of vessels, but an increase of 518.03 tons in the amount of tonnage, compared with the list of 1873. The increase of tonnage is in consequence of the new vessels added to the district being of a larger class. During the last year twenty-seven new vessels, of an aggregate tonnage of 2506.64, have been added to the District. Of these, twenty-three are schooners, one sloop, and three steamers. All of the schooners but one have been employed in the fishing business; the exception is a three-masted freighting vessel of more tonnage than the net increase in the district, making it very apparent that there is a slight decrease in the aggregate of the fishing tonnage of the district. This decrease was undoubtedly caused by the heavy losses at the Bay last summer. Ten vessels, comprising six schooners, one yacht and three boats, of 489.49 tons, have also been brought into the district from other ports.

The deductions from last year's List have been thirty schooners and one boat, of an aggregate tonnage of 1547.55 tons, which have been lost at sea; and twenty schooners and two boats, 930.55 tons, sold out of the District.

Besides the above there have been thirteen changes among the different sections of the district, making the whole number of changes in the List from last year's, one hundred and three.

Gloucester Harbor has increased her tonnage 808.80 tons, which is principally by the addition of a three-masted freighting vessel of 531.09 tons, but there is a net loss of eight in the number of schooners. There is an addition of one to the number of steamtugs, and three to the number of boats. Four schooners and one boat have been transferred from Rockport, and two schooners and one boat from Annisquam to Gloucester Harbor; while one schooner has been transferred from the Harbor to each of Manchester and Rockport.

The Annisquam fleet has been reduced one vessel from last year, there being a loss of three schooners and one boat, and an addition of one yacht and two boats—making a net loss of 22.80 tons.

At Rockport there have been many changes in its small fleet, there being now less schooners and boats, and more sloops and steamers, making in the aggregate a loss of more than one-sixth of the number of vessels last year. The additions have been one new sloop and two new steamers, one schooner from another district, and two schooners transferred from Gloucester Harbor; while the reductions have been four schooners and one boat lost at sea, six schooners and one boat sold out of the district, five schooners and one boat transferred to Gloucester Harbor, and one boat to Annisquam—making a net loss of thirteen vessels and 350.56 tons.

Manchester has added one to its number of vessels, making two in all, and Essex retains its two schooners.
